

The Portland Municipal Airport is a city owned, public use airport located three nautical miles northeast of the central business district of Portland, Tennessee. It is included in the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems for 2011–2015, which categorized it as a general aviation facility.

The Portland Municipal Airport covers an area of 157 acres at an elevation of 817 feet above mean sea level. It has one runway designated 1/19 with an asphalt surface measuring 5,000 by 100 feet.

For the 12-month period ending May 31, 2012, the airport had 12,080 aircraft operations, an average of 33 per day: 96% general aviation, 3% military, and 1% air taxi. At that time there were 45 aircraft based at this airport: 92% single-engine and 8% multi-engine.
