- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 11.2% since 2015, growing by 19,626. Population is expected to increase by 7.0% between 2020 and 2025, adding 13,644.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 8.9% in Sumner County, TN from 59,494 to 64,798. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.1% by 5.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.7% to 66.7% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.7% of Sumner County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.4% below the national average), and **8.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






## **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Sumner County, TN had a December 2020 unemployment rate of 5.05%, increasing from 4.62% 5 years before.






#### Millennials

Sumner County, TN has 36,969 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 39,440.




#### **Veterans**

Sumner County, TN has 11,978 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 10,624.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Sumner County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 56,240 people 55 or older, while there are 56,373 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Sumner County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 76,300 racially diverse people, while there are 32,441 here.




#### **Property Crime**










#### 2019 Median Hourly Earnings








