



## Average Hiring Competition Over a Thin Supply of Regional Talent




#### Supply (Jobs)

Your area is not a hotspot for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 35,662\* employees, while there are 29,109 here.



#### Compensation

The cost for talent is low in your area. The national median salary for your occupations is \$87,178, while you'll pay \$69,733 here.



#### **Demand (Job Postings)**


Competition from online job postings is about average in your area. The national average for an area this size is 2,450\* job postings/mo, while there are 2,364 here.

#### Supply Is Lower Than the National Average




#### Place of Work vs Place of Residence



#### Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is Low




#### **Retiring Soon**






#### Occupation Age Breakdown






# Compensation

#### Talent Is 20% Cheaper, While the Cost of Living May Make Attraction Difficult

In 2019, the median compensation for your occupations in your area is \$69,733. Based on the national median wage of \$87,178 for this position, this means you will spend about 20% less to employ your occupations here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 15% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 6% lower than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.






