


Workforce Map


Embedded Talent

Job posting activity is high in Sumner County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 75* job postings/mo, while there are 88 here.





Racial Diversity


Racial diversity is low in Sumner County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 2,789* racially diverse employees, while there are 1,948 here.

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sectors level.



Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






Industry Gender Breakdown






